LOCAL HIGHLIGHT: SENTOSA

Last month, local resident Matthew Lim took a trip down to Malay/Singaporean restaurant Sentosa to review and shine a spotlight on their food offering for our Local Highlight segment. Here is what Matthew had to share about his experience.

Sentosa takes its name from an island south of the Singapore mainland. Opened on Bermondsey Street in 2023, it says it offers food from both countries.

At a reasonable price (for London's ever inflating prices), Sentosa offers a range of small plates, noodles, and rice accompanied by a list of traditional drinks (and Tiger beer).

On arrival the restaurant was intimate, with a comfortable amount of space and a refreshing lack of Asian-themed decor that can so often be poorly done.

Overall, Sentosa was a wonderful restaurant providing an authentic flavour and a wide range of choices. I'd highly recommend giving Sentosa a try (and tell them to add Wan Tan Mee to the menu, something this author is lobbying for from all Malay restaurants).
